1. Ambulance build

a. We have received a quote from Braun for the new ambulance build. It has come in lower than I had expected. We will need to approve this so we can get in the que for the chassis.

2. Budget

a. we will review this in the meeting in detail. We have been working on this and a new salary schedule.

3. Salary schedule

- a. We have prepared a new salary schedule for the boards review. This will put us in the 75th percentile of the surrounding areas.
- b. I have tasked the crews with completing a schedule they would like to see.
- c. I have taken information from the crews to build the new salary schedule. If adopted this will be a living document that can be approved every year to keep current.
- d. New Salary schedule will have policy attached to it to ensure that the district an the employees are protected.
- e. We will go over this in detail during the meeting.

4. Fire assignments

- a. Our truck is currently back in service at the station.
- b. We had a total of 4 Quincy CA assignments
- c. I have been working on billing these assignments out. It is looking very good this year.

5. Christmas party

a. We need to find a Date that works for the Christmas party this year and direction on what we would like to do for food.

6. New Web page

a. The new web page is up and running. Seems to be a lot easier to navigate and utilize.

7. State PPE grant

a. We have all our orders for equipment put in at this time, we should start seeing some of the items here soon.

8. Trainings

- a. We will have a few employees going to classes this fall and into early next year. Some of the classes are Engine crew boss, Fire Instructor, Fire officer, and Fire Fighter 2.
- b. I am currently working with PV fire to coordinate a Paramedic refresher this spring for recertification process in March.

9. Mesa county chiefs

- a. Jason and I have been working on frame work for a mutual aid agreement for the county. MC chiefs are on board so far and would like us to put together a proposed agreement.
- b. This would allow a entity to utilize this system to request resources on large incidents knowing that they will receive qualified and experienced crews.
- c. This will help assure we move through the incident smoothly with unified command procedures.

10. Garfield county chiefs

a. Not much to update. They are continuing to work on the radio frequency issues they have.

11. Training Consortium

- a. Looking a Target solutions enterprise system to link departments and allow document sharing.
- This would allow us to share training documents with other departments to assure employees are getting credit for trainings at all departments.
- c. Cost is around \$500 a year to be part of this enterprise
- d. I am waiting for more information and to see if other departments are going to sign up for this.
