MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER:

Pursuant to notice, the regular board meeting of the De Beque Fire Protection District (DFPD) was called to order by Board President Tanner at 6:32 p.m. on Tuesday, August 13, 2024.

- 1) Sale of Ambulance 81. Old Ambulance 81 was put up for sale for the determined amount of time. The highest bid was \$12,350, which is \$5,150 below the amount the Board set as minimum. Discussion ensued regarding whether or not to accept the bid. Motion was made by Board President Tanner and seconded by Board Vice President Ramthun to accept the \$12,350 bid for the old Ambulance 81. - 2) Ladder 81 Repairs and Sales. Meeker Fire District is interested in purchasing Ladder 81, but there have been several issues lately that need to be taken care of before DFPD can sell it. It broke down on the way to the repair shop and had to be towed the rest of the way. The estimated tow and repair cost is \$30,000. Motion was made by Board President Tanner and seconded by Board Vice President Ramthun to approve repairs for Ladder 81, not to exceed \$30,000. Vote: Cynthia Farris, Absent; Melanie Hansen, Aye; Dustin Koehler, Absent; Maria Ramthun, Aye; Annette Tanner, Aye. Motion Passed.
